CERTIFIED INSTALLER MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Maintain a professional irrigation certification issued by a recognised training body
- Minimum of two years in operation
- Current certificate of Indemnity Insurance
- Demonstrate that staff and managers adhere to a Code of Behavior and Ethics as follows;
 - Treat each customer with respect
 - Conduct all business dealings in a legal and ethical manner
 - Continuously meet state and local licensing and insurance requirements
 - Be aware of and consider any cultural issues with sites
 - Be on time for all client meetings and site inspections
 - Be able to meet deadlines and demonstrate ability to provide appropriate resource to complete the project
 - Provide customers with a thorough “walk-through” of the completed system, including component locations and operation of key equipment
 - Exceed customer expectations by leaving each job site in the best condition possible
 - Ensure that crew members and company vehicles are equipped to the appropriate safety standards
 - Ensure that crew members and company vehicles are well presented.
 - Attend the required number of training events per year
 - Pass the annual re-certification process
